Noble Heights [Getting Austin to the top of Yosemite]

As many of you know we have a Noble Heights program where we include youth with disabilities and foster children on adventure hikes across Northern California. In the process of getting this program off of the ground we have become good friends with a local boy named Austin Taylor. Austin has used a wheel chair since he was born.

Austin Taylor wants to spend his life showing others that anything is possible. He wants to travel the world, conquer mountains and give courage to others so they may follow their own dreams.

On October 17th Generation Fate's Noble Heights Team will be hiking with Austin to reach Clouds Rest in Yosemite Valley at 10,000 feet on his first epic voyage...

...taking a giant leap of faith towards a life filled with hope, wonder and adventure...

Recently we were approached by a production company to document Austin's hike which is a great opportunity for us. They are doing it for free and plan to submit the documentary to festivals around the world. We also plan to have a showing at a local theatre for the community to view the film. Unfortunately because we will be bringing a film crew Yosemite requires that we secure more permits and a more expensive insurance at costs higher than \$2000. We don't have this in our budget so we are reaching out to the community to get some extra help...

The hike is going to happen no matter what, but we would love to take advantage of this wonderful opportunity to create a film that will generate more support for Generation Fate and most importantly allow Austin Taylor to live out his dream of inspiring thousands to do that they did not think possible.
